The Northern Regional Construction Association's Constructing Excellence Awards celebrate outstanding achievements in Northern BC's construction industry, recognizing exceptional companies, individuals, and projects.

Awards of Excellence honour those whose leadership, innovation, and commitment set them apart, while Project Awards highlight remarkable projects that exemplify quality, sustainability, and safety. These awards inspire innovation and foster growth within the industry.

The 2025 NRCA Awards are open to all NRCA Industry Members in good standing. The company must have been an NRCA Member for a minimum of three (3) months at the time of submission.

PROJECT AWARDS

Project Awards acknowledges exceptional construction projects that demonstrate quality, innovation, sustainability, and safety. These awards highlight the skill, teamwork, and commitment involved in completing remarkable projects.

Mandatory submission requirements:

- Completion of the application form
- Certificate of Substantial Completion for this project
 - o This may be submitted separately but must be submitted before February 14th
- Project description of why the nominee is worthy, including a 500-word (maximum) project summary.
- Two (2) or more letters of support validating the NRCA Award nomination.
- At least two high-resolution photographs and/or multimedia

Project Award Conditions:

- All projects must have substantial completion by January 15th, 2025
- Projects must be located in Northern British Columbia including the following regions: Skeena-Bulkley, Peace, Northern Rockies, Prince George, Cariboo, and Haida Gwaii.
- A member may only submit two (2) projects per category.
- The Chair of the NRCA Board of Directors is not eligible during the year in which they hold such a position.
- A Project Excellence Award may not be presented if, in the opinion of the judges, no suitable candidate has been nominated for the specific category.
- The decision of the Awards Committee is final and not subject to appeal.

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Project Award Conditions, Continued:

- If the entry contains any feature that is, or could be, protected by patent rights the submission must be accompanied by written evidence demonstrating that the necessary steps have been taken to secure the requisite legal protection; neither the sponsor of the NRCA Award nor the Northern Regional Construction Association (NRCA) can assume any responsibility for "prior disclosure" in advance of a patent application.
- All photographs submitted with NRCA Award nominations become the property of NRCA. These will be used to promote the NRCA Awards, the Association, and the construction industry. Photographs should be in high-resolution .jpg or .png formats.

SUPPLIER OF THE YEAR

The Supplier of the Year Award recognizes an NRCA Member Company for their overall excellence as a manufacturer/supplier in Northern BC. This award is presented to an active supplier who has shown outstanding skill in their craft. They exceed customer expectations with first-rate products and services and remains competitive in our industry.



SAFETY EXCELLENCE

The Safety Excellence Awards are designed to honour those contractors who have maintained a superior safety record during the year leading up to submission. The Safety Award will be based on a contractor's claims experience record with the Workers' Compensation Board. Three companies will be selected for this award.



MEMBERS' CHOICE

The Members' Choice Award recognizes a company that demonstrates exceptional involvement and engagement with the Northern Regional Construction Association. This award is given to a member company that actively participates in NRCA events, serves on committees, supports educational initiatives, and remains consistently involved with the association.



Fellow members will vote on the finalists to decide the recipient.

EMPLOYEE OF THE YEAR

The Employee of the Year Award recognizes an employee who has made a significant contribution and/or positive impact on the company they work for. Nominees should:

- Have outstanding performance, superior dedication, and positive attitude on the job
- · Be a leader in their respective company who has demonstrated a commitment to improving our industry
- Has demonstrated their commitment to mentoring the next generation of the construction workforce

U40 OF THE YEAR

The U40 Person of the Year Award recognizes an individual, under the age of 40, who has demonstrated industry leadership and is committed to the advancement of the construction sector. He or she will be someone who has made a significant impact or contribution to the workplace and/or a project; and to the community through volunteer work and/or business accomplishments.



JUDGING PROCESS

A panel of judges will review and score all submissions against the prescribed criteria. The judges reserve the right to re-assign entries to the category they deem fit.

The judging panel is made up of 3-4 unbiased, third-party construction and/or business professionals.
